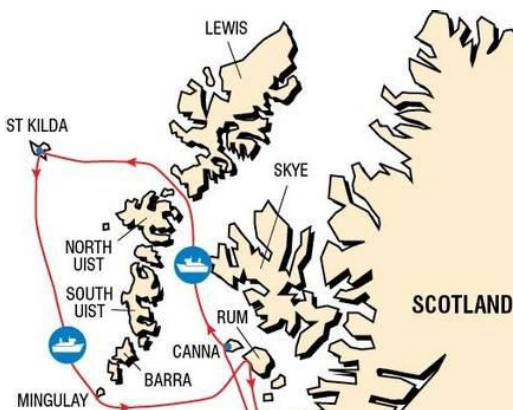


ST KILDA AND THE HEBRIDES

Zoologist Sara Frost from Naturetrek will take us on a journey to St Kilda, a UNESCO World Heritage site, sailing to the remote archipelago through the beautiful Inner and Outer Hebrides.

She will give an insight into the life of the hardy St Kildan people, who have remarkable self-sufficiency – and having worked for three years as a wildlife guide, will recount and illustrate her experiences of sightings of the wonderful wildlife inhabiting these islands and the surrounding waters... from otters, eagles and seabirds to dolphins, sharks and whales.
