## In the Recital Room at South Hill Park

Many social predators are thought to accrue fitness benefits by hunting co-operatively. However, few studies have shown conclusively that these benefits are influenced by group size. Moreover, there is little evidence to suggest that individual group members coordinate roles during a hunting event.

This study, by Berkshire College of Agriculture researcher JACK MERRIFIELD, aims to elucidate factors influencing various aspects of co-operative hunting by Black-Backed Jackals in the Namibian Desert.
