Join us for a day of birdwatching in the sheltered Arun Valley within the **South Downs National Park**. In winter the flooded meadows teem with wintering ducks, geese, swans and waders such as wigeons, teals, pintails, shovelers, lapwings, ruffs, snipe and Bewick's swans. Short-eared owls, barn owls, hen harriers, peregrines, merlins and sparrowhawks are also regularly seen.

Visitors have a choice of several trails, including a gentle 2 mile circular wetland route with four hides and three viewpoints each overlooking grassland, ditches and pools; a 1 ½ mile loop through woodland and heath which takes you up towards the Bronze Age barrow to enjoy views across the valley and the South Downs.

**There is a Visitor Centre and a cafe selling sandwiches,  
soup and hot lunches.**
